PCA SHOP CALL FOR ARTISTS

The Shop at the Pittsburgh Center for the Arts is currently seeking new consignment artists to complement the existing mix represented in the **Shop at PCA**. Only artists living or working within a 150-Mile radius of the Center will be considered.

A **screening** for new artists will be held on **Saturday May 12th, 2007 from 11-3** at Pittsburgh Center for the Arts, 6300 Fifth Avenue. On the day of the screening, artists should drop off a representation (2-3 works per media) of their work, and a brief Artist Statement between 11 and 12 p.m. and be prepared to pick up their work between 2 and 3 p.m. that same day. If your work is selected for the Shop, an appointment for delivery of inventory will be set.

Quality of work as well as the diversity of the work in comparison to existing inventory will drive the Screening Committee's decision as to who to include in PCA's Shop. We are particularly interested in the artists overall "hand" in the creation of the finished work. Ex: jewelry artists must be creating the "elements" of finished design.

Artworks in a wide variety of media are showcased in PCA's Shop year round. At this time we are particularly encouraging artists working in Glass, and artisan toys to compliment our upcoming exhibitions and selection.

The Pittsburgh Center for the Arts is a non-profit arts organization located in the neighborhood of Shadyside. Founded by Regional Artists in 1945 as an exhibition and meeting space, a school, and a shop to promote the sale of Artists work.
